We are pleased to inform you that Dallas School District will implement a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2022-2023.

What does this mean for you and your children? Great news for you and your children!

All enrolled students of

Lyle Elementary School
Whitworth Elementary School
Oakdale Elementary School
Morrison Campus Alternative School
Polk County Adolescent Treatment Center

are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2022-2023 school year. No further action is required of you. Your children will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay for meals or submit an application.

However, if children in your household attend LaCreole Middle School or Dallas High School, we encourage you to complete a confidential meal application if your family falls within the attached Oregon income guidelines. We are hoping to continue free meal service at those locations as well.
