Who we serve

We welcome children who have medical and behavioral needs, including sensory issues, autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, cerebral palsy, and developmental and speech/language delays. We also welcome children who have complex medical issues.

Our goal is to be the dental home for families of children and young adults with special health care needs. We serve these patients and their siblings from birth to 21 years of age. We recommend that a child's first dental appointment take place when their first tooth comes in and no later than his or her first birthday.

Our clinic provides comprehensive oral health care, based on the unique needs of each child. We offer preventive dental services and restorative dental procedures. Our dentists use the following to ensure a positive dental experience for each child:

- Behavioral guidance
- Nitrous oxide
- Hospital and clinical-based dentistry under general anesthesia
